

This week on the course

Monday 4th February

Following an inspection of the course we proceeded to turf the worn area in the orchard near the first tee using the remainder of the turf that was saved from the 2nd and 15th tee boxes.

Tuesday 5th February

It had been noted that throughout the winter there had been a large amount of debris from trees along the back track/path from the 9th green through to the 10th tee, which we cleared and burnt in the woods at the 8th.

Wednesday 6th February

With the ground conditions still being unsuitable to work at the 4th we continued to prune back trees on the course, this time working in the pine copse at the back of the 8th green. There are a couple of reasons for carrying out this work, allowing for better air flow through the trees to the green and surrounds, allowing a better shot into the green if anyone is unfortunate enough to carry through into the trees and to minimise any damage to machinery that cut in and around the copse.

Thursday 7th February

With a little bit give in the ground the turfing at the orchard was completed. We then started to prune the pine copse at the back of the 2nd green.

Friday 8th February

Following a general check of the course and moving of tee positions we continued to work at the 2nd copse. Following completion of the orchard we moved on to turfing the damaged area around the tree at the back of the 18th green. Looking forward at the forecast we aim to complete the bunkers at the 4th next week.
