This week on the course

Monday 5th November

With leaves falling from the trees over the weekend the day began with removing leaves from the greens and tee areas around the course with the greens begin mowed afterwards. After allowing the drain lines a couple of weeks to settle work began on the 12th green to reinstate the turf.



Tuesday 6th November

Work on the 12th green was today completed, we then moved on to start laying the turf on the 16th green. All greens and temporary greens were mowed.

Wednesday 7th November

Another breezy night meant that leaves and other debris was needed to be removed from tees and the greens before play. The bins around the course were emptied with the ball washers being topped up. White lines were sprayed out around the temporary greens and front lawns around the clubhouse were mown. The work on the 16th green was completed meaning that all the turf had now been reinstated on both greens. The turf will now be left to root in and for the drain lines to settle further for a few weeks before we begin the rolling process allowing the surface to be playable for the beginning of the playing season next spring.



Thursday 8th November

Following a damp start to the day the greens were switched to removed the morning dew, with the bunkers checked for any holes or footprints and the tee markers were moved position. In preparation for work to start on the 15th tee we moved the mat from the old practice net area in the orchard and placed it at the front of the tee box. The process of picking up leaves was continued.

Friday 9th November

The morning began with the usual need for clearing greens of leaves, also some of the bunkers on the course had to be cleared of leaves before they were raked. Greens and aprons were mowed in preparation for the weekends play and tee markers were again moved positions. We also began to remove the furniture off the golf course to be stored indoors to allow to dry out and then for wood treatment to be applied for the start of the new season next year.
