

## **This week on the course**

### **Monday 25th March**

Following an inspection of the course, where the bunkers were checked and the tee markers were moved following the weekend's golf, the greens were mowed. After a dry spell of weather we continued our work on the footpaths where we topped up the paths at the 4th and 10th tees with red track.

### **Tuesday 26th March**

Today we began by mowing the main greens. It was decided that we would start work on the bunkers by edging around the bunkers, once we have completed this process we will then move on to topping up any bunkers that require any more sand. Today also saw the introduction of the 'traffic light' system on the greens for the pin positions, The 3 colours and what positions they represent are as follows

Front = Red  
Middle = Yellow  
Back = Blue

### **Wednesday 27th March**

the main greens were again mowed and we continued to edge bunkers



### **Thursday 28th March**

The main greens were mown and we worked on a few bunkers in the morning. We then moved on to some cutting around the course. The fairways, the first 2 cuts of semi rough, aprons and

the bunker face were all mown. The stakes around the ponds on 3, 4, 10 and 15 were all painted red.

### **Friday 29th March**

Following a frosty start to the day the greens were not mown, the rest of the course furniture, seats and summer tee markers, were put out around the course. Cutting was continued on the semi rough aprons and some of tee boxes. The first tee was mown with the hand machine. Remaining stakes were put out on the ditches around the course.
