This week on the course

Monday 8th April

The day began with the bunkers being checked and the tee markers being moved. The greens were verti-cut to a depth of 1mm and the greens were mown. The first cut of semi rough around the fairways were cut. aeration work began on the greens with the new verti-drain machine that the golf club have recently purchased, the greens were tined with 8mm tines to a depth of 3 1/2 inches.

Tuesday 9th April

The greens were mown and the aeration work on the greens continued. The aprons and surrounds of the greens were mown as was the fairways and the semi rough once the first cuts around the fairways were finished. Divoting work began on the tee boxes.

Wednesday 10th April

Following a frosty start to the day the greens were mown and the bunkers were fully raked for the competition. the devoting work continued and also some bare areas around the course were seeded and dressed out with sand. Mowing of the fairways and semi rough continued.

Thursday 11th April

Following another frosty start the greens were mown as were the tees, aprons, fairways, semi rough and the practice ground.

Friday 12th April

The greens were mown, tee markers moved position and the pin positions were also moved. the mowing of the semi rough, tees an aprons was finished. The topdresser was put on the workman machine ready for topdressing of the greens on Monday.
