

This week on the course

Monday 14th May

The bunkers and the tee markers were checked. The greens, tees aprons and the 1st cut of semi rough were cut. Cutting of the fairways began. We planned to verti cut the greens the following day so to get a head start on this we verti cut the 3 practice greens.

Tuesday 15th May

With a heavy dew on the greens we needed to brush the greens using the small John Deere tractor prior to the verti cutting, following this the greens were cut and were rolled using the turf iron to help regain a smooth putting surface following the verti cut. The cutting of the fairways was completed and the practice area was also cut. The aprons were cut as were some of the pathsides

Wednesday 16th May

The greens were cut, pin and tee positions were moved and the bunkers were fully raked. Fairways and semi rough were cut as were some tee sides and path sides around the course.

Thursday 17th May

The greens were cut, pin and tee positions were moved and bunkers were fully raked. The practice area was cut as were the front lawns around the clubhouse. Again with limited work being able to be done on the course due to the ladies county event we used this time for machinery maintenance.

Friday 18th May

The greens were cut, bunkers and markers were checked. The remaining fairways and aprons were cut and the bins were emptied around the course and then ball washers were topped up.
